### **Local Criminal Justice Board Business Planning 2012 - 2013**

#### **1 Purpose of the Report**

- 1.1 To update members on key objectives of local criminal justice partners in York and North Yorkshire for 2012/13.

#### **2 Background**

- 2.1 The Local Criminal Justice Board (LCJB), brings together senior representatives from the key criminal justice agencies from York and North Yorkshire (North Yorkshire Police, York & North Yorkshire Probation Trust, Her Majesty's Court Service, Crown Prosecution Service, Youth Justice Services, Victim Support and the Prison Service). The structure of the LCJB is outlined in Appendix 1.
- 2.2 The key outcomes which the agencies are looking to deliver through working in partnership are;
- Reduced reoffending and reduced crime
  - Improved victim and witness satisfaction
  - Improved efficiency (more for less)

The work programme for 2012/13 for the LCB is outlined at Appendix 2.

#### **3 Partnership & Planning**

- 3.1 There are clearly significant links between the key objectives of the criminal justice agencies and the overall community safety responsibilities held by Local Authorities. Indeed the Reducing Reoffending Board is a sub group of both the LCJB and the York & North Yorkshire Community Safety Forum.
- 3.2 From the LCJB there is a wish to consider developing greater links between the business planning of the criminal justice agencies and the wider partnership landscape which the Chief Executive's Group oversees and we would welcome some discussion about how this could be taken forward.

#### **4 Recommendations**

- 4.1 That the structure and business objectives of the LCJB are noted.
- 4.2 That discussion is initiated about how greater integration of business planning could be achieved.

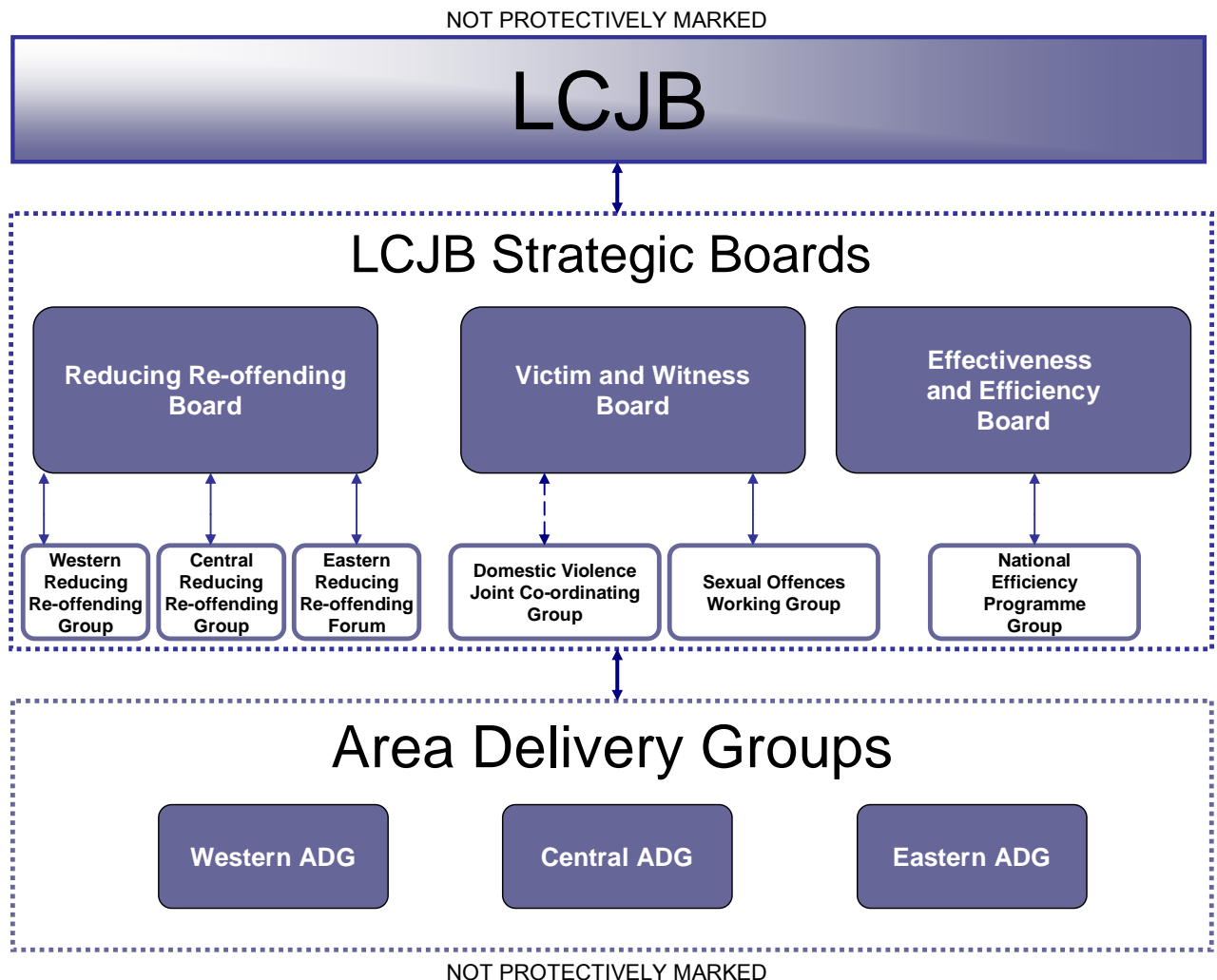
