### POWERS OF THE NORTH YORKSHIRE POLICE AND CRIME PANEL

- 5. In accordance with the Schedule I of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011. The Panel is enabled to:
  - review the proposed appointment, by holding a Confirmation Hearing within three weeks of notification being given ( A 'confirmation hearing' is a

meeting of the Panel, held in public, at which the candidate is requested to appear for the purpose of answering questions relating to the appointment);

- make a report to the Commissioner on the proposed senior appointment;
- include a recommendation to the Police and Crime Commissioner as to whether or not the candidate should be appointed; and
- publish the report to the commissioner made under this paragraph.

# 6. CONFIRMATION HEARING FOR THE ROLE OF CHIEF EXECUTIVE

- 7. On 23 April 2013, the Panel received notification from the North Yorkshire Police and Crime Commissioner of the proposed appointment to the role of Chief Executive
- 8. The Confirmation Hearing was held on Thursday, 25 April 2013 in the Severus Room, West Offices in the City of York Council Offices. The Hearing was held in public.
- 9. Julia Mulligan introduced Ms Joanna Carter to the Panel. The Commissioner referred to her report and supporting papers, which outlined the process of selection and the reasons why she was proposing that Ms Joanna Carter be appointed as Chief Executive Officer.
- 10. The Panel asked questions of the candidate, relating to her professional competence, the answers to which enabled the Members to evaluate her suitability for the role.
- 11. The Panel explored the candidate's ability to undertake the role through an appraisal of the supporting documents provided by the Commissioner, and through questioning.

### RECOMMENDATION

12. On the basis of the information provided by the Commissioner; the discussions held in the Confirmation Hearing; and examination of the evidence in both the public meeting and the closed session; the Panel is pleased to endorse the appointment of Ms Joanna Carter to the role of Chief Executive.
