Chief Executives' Group – North Yorkshire and York 15 June 2017

Representation on the North Yorkshire Health and Wellbeing Board

1 Purpose of the Report

1.1 To seek confirmation that the existing District Council representation on the North Yorkshire Health and Wellbeing Board ("the Board") should continue.

2 Background

- 2.1 The North Yorkshire Health and Wellbeing Board is a Committee established by statute (Health and Social Care Act 2012).
- 2.2 It has 19 Members. This includes representation from North Yorkshire County Council (at Member and Chief Officer level), Clinical Commissioning Groups, Age UK North Yorkshire, NHS England, Healthwatch North Yorkshire and providers.
- 2.3 There is also provision for one Member and Officer from the District Councils to represent the views of the Districts and to report back to them on the issues considered at the Board.
- 2.4 The current District Council representatives at Member and Officer level, respectively, are Councillor Richard Foster (Leader of Craven District Council) and Janet Waggott (Chief Executive of Selby District Council and also the Assistant Chief Executive at North Yorkshire County Council).
- 2.5 Some Members are on the Board statutorily, by virtue of their position, such as the Corporate Director for Health and Adult Services. The District Council representatives are not required to be on the Board statutorily.
- 2.6 The District Council representatives have not, as far as I am aware, been appointed for a prescribed period but, in view of the recent County Council elections, which have resulted in some change to Board Membership, it seems appropriate to seek confirmation that the Group is agreeable for the existing Members to continue to represent the District Councils, should the individuals concerned be happy to do this, or to nominate new representatives.

3 Recommendation

3.1 The Chief Executives Group is asked to confirm the existing District Council representation on the Board, or to nominate new representatives.
