### York and North Yorkshire – a beautiful place with some of the best ingredients available for growth



#### Yet these strengths are undermined by significant challenges:

Productivity lags behind national levels - From 2004 to 2023, the average output was approx. 90.5% of the national average Decline in young people (aged 16 to 24) – from 2011 to 2022, there was a decrease of 6.3%

Wage levels are below national levels, particularly along the coast and in rural pockets, and a proportion of residents commute out of the area for jobs that are better paid

**13-year age gap** between most wealthy and most deprived communities

6% of neighbourhoods are in the 20% <u>most deprived</u> in England

<u>Unaffordable housing</u> – 2.5x over what is considered affordable
