

**Police, Fire and Crime Panel Expenditure  
April 2022 to March 2023**

North Yorkshire County Council received £65,260 as host authority in grant from the Home Office for the 2022/23 financial year to be able to support the Police, Fire and Crime Panel.

A breakdown of how this grant was used in this period is outlined below.
